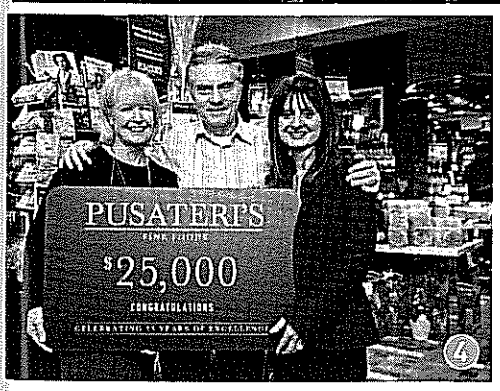
2 GALLERIA SHARES THE LOVE

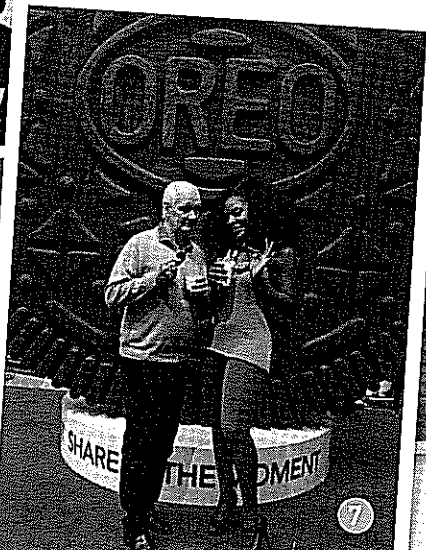
5 NORTH WEST AWARDS TOP EMPLOYEES
