

Congratulations to Maggie MacDonnell 2017 Global Teacher Prize recipient

The Global Teacher Prize is presented annually to an exceptional teacher who has made an outstanding contribution to their profession. When the team returned from Hawaii they toured surrounding villages, sharing their experiences, spreading hope and inspiring youth to start their own run clubs.
