## Expanded Northern store means more food services and retail jobs in Sandy Lake, ON

Both services will offer fresh, cooked to order meals and longer hours of operation to better serve the community. With new services come new jobs, and Northern is now able to offer even more employment opportunities.

Chief Kakegamic and her Council are terrific to work with and I thank them for their support.
